STATUS AND UPCOMING SCHEDULE

- Sequenced Activation (Go Live)
 - July 13: Traffic Information Boards Announcement Message
 - July 19: Ramp Meters Rest in Green
 - July 26: Ramp Meters ON
 - September 1: Lane Use and Speed Signs and Information Boards
 w/ Traveler Info ON
 - Late September: <u>All Strategies ON</u>
- Signal Retiming: November 2016 to April 2017
- After Studies: November 2016 to May 2017

- Started Operations of Lane Use and Speed Signs on August 25, 2016
 - 10 Lane Blocking Incidents
 - 3 EB
 - 7 WB
 - 1 3 Lanes Blocked
 - No reported/observed secondary accidents




RAMP METERING UPDATE JULY/AUGUST

- 8 12 engineers in the field during initial activation
 - All onramps were monitored
- Operated as expected
 - Typical driver behavior
- Onramp queues were contained to ramps
- Ramp Metering Works
 - Improved freeway performance for both peak periods



INRIX Travel Times: Eastbound I-80 from Powell St. to Pomona St.





RAMP METERING UPDATE AUGUST/SEPTEMBER


- Regular monitoring and adjustments
- Typical Fall traffic patterns returned at end of August
- Potential Trends:
 - Traffic volumes up compared to 2014 2015
 - PM Peak period expanding
 - Metering improved off-peak, AM WB commutes
 - Impacts at select locations on San Pablo Ave
 - Need more data and larger measurement period

- San Pablo Ave Congestion near RTE 4 (AM Commute)



MOVING FORWARD

WE ARE HERE TO HELP

- Activate of San Pablo Ave incident management strategies
 - Late September
- Monitor corridor performance and optimize metering rates for fall traffic patterns
 - Monitor and evaluate all ramps
 - Evaluate 2 Cars per Green @ WB RTE 4
 - Late September to early October
- Review reported safety complaints and develop action plans as needed
- Implement bypass restrictions at affected off/on ramps
 - Request CHP and local PD to enforce
 - Late 2016
- Collect traffic counts and develop traffic models for San Pablo Ave for traffic signal optimization
 - Late 2016 to early 2017
