I-80 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Contra Costa County, Project 3J070

Project Location

This project is in Contra Costa County on Interstate 80 (I-80) from the State Route 4 separation (Post Mile 10.1) in Hercules, to the Carquinez Bridge (Post Mile 13.5), in Crockett.





Project Need

The existing pavement exhibits signs of distress, resulting in poor ride quality and the potential for pavement failure.





Project Purpose

101

To extend the service life of the pavement and enhance highway safety.



- Project Scope
- 26 lane-miles of pavement resurfacing and restoration for the mainline freeway and ramps within the project limits
- Electrical, Drainage, signing work
- Upgrading curb ramps at ramp termini to be ADA compliant
- Construction Capital Cost is \$50m
- State Highway Operations & Protection Program (SHOPP) & SB1 funding

 - July 21, Friday (9:00pm) July 24, Monday (5:00am)
 - August 4, Friday (9:00pm) August 7, Monday (5:00am)
 - August 18, Friday (9:00pm) August 21, Monday (5:00am)

Westbound (104 hours) – Labor Day Weekend

August 31, Thursday (9:00pm) – September 5, Tuesday (5am)

Need for Full Closure

Removal of existing paving and installation of Continuously Reinforced Concrete Pavement (**CRCP**) is a labor and equipment intensive operation.

Safety of Caltrans and Contractor staff.

Safety of travelling public.

Performing weeks of overnight work in each weekend.





Benefits of CRCP


4 weekend closures vs. Over 120 nights of closures

Project should finish in late 2023 instead of late 2024.

Improved ride quality now - CRCP has no joints.

Improved ride quality later – less likely to crack / settle / rock in future due to reinforcing steel.


Eastbound I-80 Closed at SR4

San Jose / Hayward Area traffic diverted to EB 580 to I-5








Major Regional Detours for WB 80


Westbound I-80 Closed at I-780
